CHIROPRACTIC QUALIFICATIONS

The D.C. curriculum includes classroom hours that are equivalent to allopathic (M.D.) and osteopathic (D.O.) medical disciplines.

In some areas, such as anatomy, physiology, rehabilitation, nutrition and public health, chiropractic students receive more intensive education than their M.D. counterparts.*

- Assessing patients through laboratory testing, clinical examination and diagnostic imaging
